Punctuality - the school day starts at **8.50am** and children may arrive from **8.40am**. Please help your child to be on time, thank you.

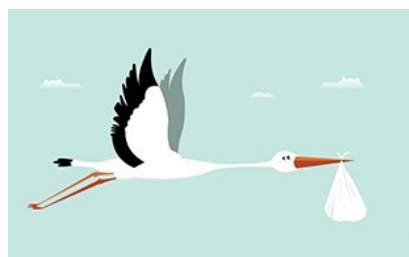
- **Sports Day** will take place on **Thursday, 23 June**, weather permitting. Reception and Nursery in the morning and KS1/KS2 in the afternoon.
