### Sports Day



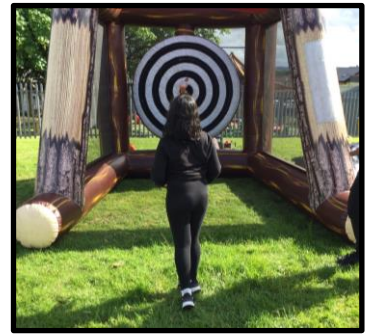
We all had a fantastic time at our Sports Day.
