


What happens when I get to nursery?

"I'm going to use lots of sticky glue for my picture," she says.




What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

You can have fruit whenever you feel hungry. You will have milk at snack time, and you can use your water bottle whenever you are thirsty.


The children are sitting at the snack table. Rebecca is eating a pear, and Dylan and Cora have a milk carton.

Insha is going to the toilet.


"Everything here is the right size for me, and it's easy to use because I practise going by myself when I am at home," she says.

"I always wash my hands with soap and water after I go to the toilet, to clean away all the germs," she says.


If you have a toilet accident, your grown-ups will bring in some of your clothes for you to change into. If you don't have any, nursery will have some spare clothes you can wear.
