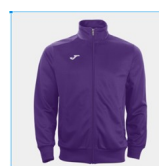

The price of a school meal has increased to **£2.47** per day (£12.35 per week) from this term. Please inform the office if you wish to change the current lunch arrangements for your child. All payments will need to be made **via the Weduc app** and meals to be chosen at home, again via the app. A guide is available under 'Parent Information' on the Weduc app you need to refer to it. Children who receive free school meals still need to make their choices at home, including those in KS1 and Early Years.
