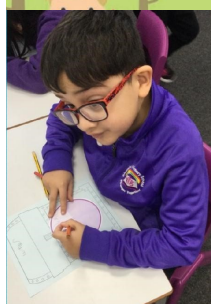
We are in the top third of all schools in Bolton's League Tables.
