As readers and writers we will:

In Autumn 1, we will Read 'The Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward and write a story based upon the model text using our own ideas for a change of character and machine.

We will read the poem 'From a Railway Carriage' by Robert Louis Stevenson and we will write our own rhyming poem. In Autumn one, we will share the story of 'The Giraffe, the Pelly and Me' by Roald Dahl as a class.

In Autumn 2, we will read 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' by Jan Oke and write a recount of historical events from the text from Major Glad's point of view.. We will read 'At the Zoo' by WM Thackeray and write a list poem. We will share 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl as a class.


During our reading lessons we will continue to focus on using and applying our phonics and answering comprehension questions.

As computer users we will:

- Continue to learn how to be safe online.
- Learn word processing skills including touch typing.
- Make storyboards and simple animation creations using our iPads.

As mathematicians we will:

- Recognise and count amounts of money- coins and notes
- Compare amounts of money
- Calculate amounts of money and find change
- Recognise, make and add equals groups
- Make arrays
- Make equal groups to group and share performing multiplication and division
- Learn our 2.5 and 10 times tables
- Double and half number
- · Recognise even and odd numbers

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As geographers we will:
